Application points will be awarded based on letter grades given for the courses listed on the advising sheet.

1. Yellow courses with a grade of C- or better meet point requirements and are required prior to Fall entry.
2. HO 100, EL115H, DA 110 & 103 are not required to apply but are eligible for application points.
3. Green courses are limited to students in the program - with the exception of DA 110 and DA 103
4. Guided Studies, Pre-Prep, Prep 1 courses do not meet program requirements.
5. All students who have applied to Lane and are Oregon Residents can apply for the program.
6. There is no minimum point requirement. Students can apply prior to completing any or all of the courses listed as eligible for points.
