- 1) **Bolded**=Courses for application points. All bolded courses are fall entry requirements except EL 115,EL 115H or EL 115R
- 2) Can graduate with Basic Health Care certificate with the bolded courses completed (Human Relations and EL 115 are not needed for BHC).
- 3) Guided Studies/Pre-Prep and Prep 1 terms-for students who place in lower math and writing. It is not recommended to complete DA pre-reqs yet
- 4) H= WR 122 or WR 123 will be accepted. Wavied for students with a prior bachelors degree, verified by transcript from US accredited college
- 5) OR = Can choose to do BI 231-233 instead of HO 150 and HO 152. BI 112 + CH 112 are the pre-reqs for BI 231. MTH 060 is the pre-req for CH 112. The anatomy sequence is worth more points and will add 2 more terms to this planner
- 6) DA = DA 110 can be used instead of HO 150/152 for the Fall 2015 only.
- 7) DA human relations - see DA catalog insert for approved DA human relations
- 8) Application available in March. Applications are due in April for Fall entry. A second application may open if spaces remain
- 9) AGS - Associate of General Studies. DA students can obtain an AGS by taking a few extra courses before and after the DA program.
- 10) The amount of courses vary depending on where a student starts with Math and Reading/Writing
