### APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS OVERVIEW

- ✓ To apply to this program, you must complete and submit the following by the close date
- ✓ Establish email account – make sure it accepts the Lane Community College email address
- ✓ Be admitted to Lane Community College as a college credit student and have an assigned L number
- ✓ Be an [Oregon resident](#) by date of application
- ✓ Have current HOBET screening test completed
- ✓ Have attendance form signed after participation in Mandatory Application Review session
- ✓ **Complete prerequisites to apply as listed in application with a letter grade of C- or better by the end of Winter term for Fall entry**
- ✓ Complete the Program Online Application & Payment
- ✓ Submit the Application Packet to Health Professions Application Center as directed
- ✓ Submit official sealed non-Lane transcripts, if needed, to Enrollment Services by deadline
- ✓ Review the Dental Hygiene [Lane Catalog](#) information to be aware of program costs in addition to tuition.

In addition to the above courses, students must complete:

1. HOBET testing: Health Occupations Basic Entrance Test. Lane students are required to make an appointment through Lane's [Testing Office](#). A testing fee is required.
2. Attend a mandatory review session. Attendance forms are in the DH application packet –<http://www.lanecc.edu/hp>

**Complete entrance testing and submit all forms by posted deadline. This may include:** Application Point Petition sheet, Work Verification Form (if applicable), Proof of Mandatory Application Review Session Attendance, Official sealed Transcripts or CLEP test results (if applicable).

The following **program requirement** courses (BI 233, BI 234, WR 123 or 227) completed with a grade of C- or higher are eligible for additional application points if they appear on a Lane transcript or submitted official sealed transcript from other institutions.

Year 3: Accepted 2<sup>nd</sup> year: Dental Hygiene Core courses and clinical- full time schedule
