

## 2011-12 ASSOCIATE OF ARTS OREGON TRANSFER (AAOT)

- The AAOT degree requirements, as listed below, must be completed within 5 years of the beginning of the academic year represented on this form. For example, students who began their studies during the 2011-12 academic year must complete the degree requirements by the end of Spring 2016.
- Developmental courses may not be used for this degree. These courses are identified by course numbers 001-099 (e.g. RD 080 or MTH 060). In addition, the following courses are considered developmental: ENG 110, ENG 116, ENG 117, RD 115, WR 110, WR 115 (before Summer 1999) and WR 120.
- Minimum of 90 credits required; 2.0 minimum cumulative GPA required; all degree requirements must be completed with a minimum grade of "C-."

## 1. FOUNDATIONAL SKILLS:

All courses must be at least 3 credits each except Health / Wellness requirement

**ENGLISH COMPOSITION:**

**Eight credits** from the following: **WR 121** Composition: Intro to Academic Writing; and **WR 122** Composition: Argument, Style and Research; or **WR 227** Technical Report Writing

*If total credits for two writing courses do not equal or exceed eight credits, a third writing course will be required to include WR 121 and WR 122 plus WR 123 or WR 227.*
