	Application deadline: Mid April 2012 – see posted application <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Application forms, point sheets and transcripts must be submitted by posted deadline dates • Online forms and payment must be submitted by posted deadline date • Winter term 2012 transcripts from colleges other than Lane submitted by posted deadline date.
	Minimum Application Requirements: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be an Oregon resident • Establish an email account • Complete Lane's application process. • Review all application materials and complete Dental Hygiene application • All courses for points must appear on a Lane Transcript by date of application. Courses from other institutions must meet course equivalency requirements and appear on submitted transcripts. • Complete the following courses – MTH 052 or higher; BI112&CH112; WR 121; BI 231, 232; FN 225; one Social Science; one Speech and one Psychology – see information as listed below. • Complete required entrance testing. More application for more information. • To be competitive complete these courses and the ones listed below.
	Application points will be awarded based on letter grades given for the courses listed above and the following courses: BI233, BI234, WR 123 or 227 and SPAN 101 and SPAN 102.
	Grade requirements: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All courses must be completed with a grade of C- or better.
	Complete Fall Entry requirements – this information will be provided in the posted application materials.
	Math Requirement: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • MTH 052 Math for Introductory Physical Science or higher – Prerequisite is MTH 020 or equivalent content with a grade of C- or better or pass the Lane math placement test.
	Science Basics: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • BI 112/CH 112 Cell Biology and Chemistry for Health Occupations or CH 104 Introductory Chemistry completed Fall 2005 or later – prerequisite is completion of MTH 052 or higher or passing Lane placement tests parts D, E or F. CH 104 Introductory Chemistry does not count as a prerequisite for Lane's Anatomy and Physiology sequence of courses.
	Anatomy and Physiology (AP) Bi 231,232&233 12 quarter credits. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • BI 233 or equivalent will not count if completed before Fall 2005. • BI 231 prerequisite: BI 112/CH 112 pass or grade of C- or better • Lane BI112/CH112 Prerequisite: Pass or C- or better Math 52 or higher or Placement tests part D, E or F
	Microbiology BI 234 completed Fall 2005 or later: BI 231, 232 & 233 are the required prerequisites or instructor consent.
	FN 225 Nutrition 4 quarter credits
	WR 121 & WR 123 or 227 English Composition courses 6 to 8 quarter credits. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prerequisite for WR 121 - WR 115 or pass Lane reading and writing placement tests. • Prerequisite for WR 123 – WR 121 and WR 122. Prerequisite for WR 227 – WR 121 only.
	Sociology Course – Choose one: SOC 204 Introduction to Sociology, 205 Social Stratification and Systems or 206 Institutions and Social Change.
	General Psychology Course – Choose one: PSY 201, 202 or 203 – Recommended these courses be taken in sequence and that a student has completed or is ready to take WR 121.
	Speech Course – Choose one: Speech 100 Basic Communication or SP 111 Public Speaking
	Work Experience: 960 paid hours or more in a Dental Office supervised by a Dentist – is eligible for additional application points. Please review application materials carefully.
	Spanish Language Proficiency – Completion of Spanish 101 and 102 or Spanish CLEP test score of 50 or higher. Please review application information carefully. Courses may be completed with a grade of C- or higher or pass.
	Attend Mandatory Application Review Session – see posted dates in application materials
	Complete entrance testing and submit all forms by posted deadline. This may include: Application Point sheet, Work Verification Form (if applicable), Proof of Mandatory Application Review Session Attendance, Transcripts and sealed CLEP test results (if applicable).
