- ✓ Complete prerequisites with a letter grade of C or better by the end of Spring or Summer term for Winter entry. Grades of C- or less do not meet criteria

- ✓ Submit the Application Packet to Health Professions Application Center as directed
- ✓ Submit non-Lane transcripts, if needed, to Enrollment Services by deadline
