• No additional application fee will be assessed for Fall 2011 RN program applicants.

• Copies of Transcripts/Course Substitution and Equivalency Forms already submitted will be reviewed

• Proof of current OSBN Certification and work hours must be submitted by announced date.

Additional application points will be provided for the following completed courses: HO 100 Medical Terminology and Human Anatomy and Physiology 2 and 3 - BI 232 and 233 and a Diversity Course (see page 49 Lane Catalog. Students with 960 hours paid CNA recent work experience (last 5 years) may be eligible for additional points. Point distribution will be provided at Information Session.

Winter 2012 Entry Prerequisites must be completed to start: In addition to application prerequisites - BI 232, BI 233, HO 100, PSY 201, CIS 101 or *computer proficiency, OSBN Nursing Assistant Certification and CPR. Transferable or equivalent courses may be accepted to meet the above requirements.

Anatomy and Physiology (AP) Bi 231,232&233 12 quarter credits. These courses expire in 7 years.

- BI 231 is a minimum application requirement. BI 232 and 233 are a Winter 2012 entry requirement.
- If any of these three courses were completed prior to Winter term 2005 please consult an Advisor/Counselor
- BI 231 prerequisite: BI 112/CH 112 pass or grade of C- or better
- Lane BI112/CH112 Prerequisite: Pass or C- or better Math 52 or higher or Placement tests part D, E or F

WR 121 Introduction to Academic Writing 3 to 4 quarter credits is a required to apply. Waived for students with a BA/BS degree. Please refer to the 2012 LPN Nursing Information and Forms Packet.

Prerequisite: WR 115 or pass Lane reading and writing placement tests

HO 100 Medical Terminology or equivalent – graded C- or higher a Winter 2012 entry requirement **PSY 201** General Psychology – co-requisite is WR 121 – graded C- or higher-Winter 2012 entry requirement

Program Overview:

Year 1 Prerequisites to apply (typically takes 4 to 6 terms to complete)- MTH 065 or higher, BI112/CH112, WR 121, HO 100, BI 231, WR 121, CNA Training. Applied for Fall 2011 RN program entry. (This will change for the following Winter 2013 program entry.

Additional Requirements to Enroll in Winter term 2012 – OSBN CNA Certification, BI 232, BI 233 and General Psychology PSY 201. Students are expected to have computer proficiency – recommended courses are CI 101 Computer Fundamentals or CS 120 Concepts of Computing.
