Program Overview:

Year 1 Prerequisites to apply (typically takes 3 to 5 terms to complete) - MTH 065 or higher, WR 121, HO 100, BI 231, WR 121. BI112/CH112 courses are the prerequisite for BI 231. Students should plan to complete CNA training no later than Summer term 2012 and certification no later than Fall term 2012.

Additional Requirements to Enroll in Winter term 2013 – OSBN CNA Certification, BI 232, BI 233 and General Psychology PSY 201. Students are expected to have computer proficiency – recommended courses are CI 101 Computer Fundamentals or CS 120 Concepts of Computing.
