Students should plan to complete CNA training no later than Summer term 2012 and certification no later than Fall term 2012.<br><br>Additional Requirements to Enroll in Winter term 2013 – OSBN CNA Certification, BI 232, BI 233 and General Psychology PSY 201. Students are expected to have computer proficiency – recommended courses are CI 101 Computer Fundamentals or CS 120 Concepts of Computing. |
