Program Overview: Application and program requirements – subject to change.

- Year 1 LPN and completion of LPN to RN Prerequisites (Typically takes 4 to 6 terms to complete) - see LPN Academic Advising Guide and the prerequisite list provided below.
- Year 2
- Complete OSBN LPN Program and Licensure. Obtain 500 hours paid LPN work experience. Take ATI Step Exam If applying for RN second year– Complete Phase 1 Application by November 1st or application deadline. Once accepted in Winter and Spring terms complete Pharmacology/Pathophysiology courses and work to accumulate Year 3 1000 hours work experience by the completion of NRS 115 A and B.
- Summer term bridge course to RN complete total of 1000 hours work experience complete Phase 2 Application if space available in an OCNE institution enter RN 2nd year in the Fall. Year 4

Lane Community College is an Oregon Consortium for Nursing Education (OCNE) partner school that allows admitted students into their OCNE-RN two-year degree Associate of Applied Science Nursing program to be co-admitted to Oregon Health Sciences University with an option to complete a Bachelor's degree with a major in Nursing.

- Phase 1: LPN Applicants are selected for eligibility to enroll in NRS 230 and NRS 232. To enroll in NRS 230 and NRS 232 students are required to have 45 credits that include the following or equivalent courses: MTH 095 or higher, BI 112, BI 231, BI 232, BI 233, BI 234, FN 225, PSY 215, WR 121, WR 122 an HR course and additional approved electives to meet credit requirement.
- Phase 2: Selection for admission or alternate status combines the points obtained in Phase 1 with up to points for grades completed in NRS 230 and NRS 232.
- Phase 3: Selection for admission or alternate status is based on point ranking and allows students to complete the Bridge Summer Couse(s) NRS 115 A and B.

Minimum grade criteria is C or higher. Transferable or equivalent courses may be accepted to meet the above requirements. If you have questions please Email NursingProgram@lanecc.edu.

Prior to Phase 1 - 30 credits are required to apply to that include the two courses with an *. All remaining courses below are required to enroll in NRS 230 and NRS 232 - See Lane Catalog page 150 for more information.
