Otherwise these must be completed by the end of Summer term 2012 • Prerequisite GPA must be at least a 3.00. <i>Graded courses of C- will not meet application requirements.</i>

MTH 243 Statistics – Prerequisite: MTH 111 College Algebra or Lane placement test
Social Science 6 or more credits in courses with these prefixes; ANTH,ECON,HST,PS,PSY,SOC and BUS
Humanities 9 or more credits in courses with these prefixes; PHL, REL, SP, TA, WS and these subject areas; Foreign Language 100 or higher, History of Art or Music, Linguistics, Music Appreciation, ENG literature, Communication and Journalism.
Upper Division courses – 15 or more credits in courses numbered 300 or 400
Foreign Language Proficiency can be met by one of the following documented options:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Two terms or higher of college level foreign language including sign language • Two years of same foreign language in high school. • Language proficiency exam • For students with English as a Second Language – proof of education completed through 8th grade or higher or equivalent in one’s native language
