4. OR = Students can choose to do BI 231-233 instead of HO 150 and HO 152. BI 112 + CH 112 are the pre-reqs for BI 231. MTH 060 is the pre-req for CH 112. The anatomy sequence is worth more points and adds 2 terms to the overall plan

5. HE = HE 262 First Aid 2 - Beyond the Basics. No substitutions allowed. New requirement as of Fall 2012

6. BI 233<sup>HO</sup> = Reserved in Fall term for accepted students. Can be completed prior to entry.

7. HR = PTA 200 meets AAS Human Relations requirement. No additional course is required. Effective October 2013.

8. Prep 1 and 2 terms are for students who place in lower math and writing. It is not recommended to complete PTA pre-reqs yet.

9. Guided Studies, Pre-Prep, Prep 1 and Prep 2 courses do not meet program requirements.

10. Application available in January. Applications are due in April for Fall entry.
