APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS OVERVIEW

- ✓ Complete and submit the following by the close date
- ✓ Establish email account that accepts @lanecc.edu
- ✓ Be admitted to Lane as a credit student and have an assigned L number
- ✓ Be an [Oregon resident](#) by date of application
- ✓ Submit your program Online Application & Payment
- ✓ Submit the Application Packet to HPApplicationCenter@lanecc.edu as directed.
- ✓ Review Point Petition sheet for specific information. Courses with grades of C- or less do not meet criteria.
- ✓ No more than 16 credits with a grade of "Pass" accepted
- ✓ Eligible courses must be completed by the Winter term prior to desired Fall term entry.
- ✓ Submit official sealed non-Lane transcripts, if needed, to Enrollment Services by deadline
- ✓ Review the PTA [Lane Catalog](#) information to be aware of program costs in addition to tuition.
- ✓ **Complete the following prerequisite courses or equivalent coursework from other institutions.** All prerequisite courses must be completed and appear on an official submitted transcript to apply
- ✓ Complete 25 Observation Hours at a minimum of two clinical sites by date of application.
