

RESPIRATORY CARE PROGRAM

ESTIMATED COSTS

Due to Budgetary uncertainty, the costs below should be viewed as approximations. Budgetary adjustments by the college may result in changes in tuition and/or fees. (Differential fees will increase if tuition rates increase.)

THE FOLLOWING COSTS REFLECT ESTIMATES ONLY. Changes in textbooks, lab fees, tuition rates, student body fees and equipment requirements may alter the true costs of the program. Estimates include costs associated with all courses in the program.

A physical examination and immunizations are required for the program (costs for exam and all required immunizations through Student Health Clinic is approximately \$528). Student health insurance is required through the duration of the academic program. These may be obtained through the college or other health care/insurance providers (\$120/term through Student Health Clinic). These requirements should be considered in determining the cost of the program.

Costs related to transportation, childcare, post-graduate credentialing and State Licensure are not included in this estimate

Licensure and post-graduate credentialing can cost up to \$740 depending on the level of credentialing and State Licensure Fees.
